

LROCA – Club Rules - Activities

Issue: 2/12/10

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These rules are the essentials applying to club activities.

- 1) All club members' vehicles on a club run or at an activity are required to:
 - a) Meet the club's constitution details given in Art. 02 (b)
 - b) Be adequately maintained
 - c) Have a current Grade sticker or have been graded, within the previous 12 months.
 - d) Carry a spare wheel and suitable jack.
 - e) Carry the minimum of "club gear" in good working order, comprising:
 - i) 2kg fire extinguisher
 - ii) First aid kit
 - iii) A KERR ('bungy') rope or strap
 - iv) Two rated shackles
 - v) Spade
 - vi) Vehicles fitted with winches must also carry:
 - (1) A wire or rope damper
 - (2) A protective strop for use on fixed objects
 - f) If a 'soft top' have a roll bar fitted.
- 2) No animals or firearms allowed at any time on any club event (applies to members and guests)
- 3) Abide by the club's alcohol and drugs policy
- 4) Seat belts to be worn (applies to both members and guests).
- 5) Drivers must have Motor Vehicle 3rd Party liability insurance cover of at least of \$2million.

If any member wishes to raise an issue concerning the rules they should approach a committee member in the first instance.
